Activity	Time	Instructions & objectives
Group Activity – "Brainstorm Media Literacy/Fact Checking Tips"	5 min	Ask participants to remember media literacy/fact checking tips, suggestions mentioned throughout the course or anything that they think of as a helpful tip for resilience to disinformation. Write down all the ideas generated within 5 minutes on a whiteboard and have it on display throughout the lesson (you can use Padlet during online training). This activity will help participants think actively about what they already have learned and will prepare them for more active listening to the video.
Video – "Tips to Protect Yourself from Disinformation"	6 min	Ask participants to pay careful attention while watching the video to identify those tips they missed during the brainstorming activity. Link: <u>https://youtu.be/n1LZYI5ZI4A</u>
Discussion	3 min	Ask participants if they identified any tips from the video that was missed in their initial list. Ask participants which of the tips they would prioritize as top 3 and would teach their friends and family members to help them become more resilient to disinformation.
Group Projects	20 min	 Divide participants into groups and ask each group to choose one of the following group projects to work on: Create a poster for people who fall into your media landscape category Create a social media post that teaches followers about media literacy Create a lesson plan for your family members or friends to teach them on social media behavior/media literacy Develop a speech for adults on how to use media and what they should look out for.

Activity	Time	Instructions & objectives
Project Presentations	15 min	Each group should be given 3-5 minutes for presenting their project. Depending on the project type and number of groups the presentation time will vary.
Wrapping Up	5 min	At the end of the final lesson, ask each participant to name one biggest take away from the course. Show slide 8 to wrap up key messages of the course. Review next steps - ask the participants to take the final test, explain to them how the certificate will be generated and how they will need to hand it in after they finish.
